Are You Ready for a Flashback?

May 14, 2009 - Greensboro, NC- Get ready for a trip back in time with the Regency Companies Flashback Friday Concert Series! Music enthusiasts will enjoy two classic rock concerts – May 22 featuring 1964: The Tribute and June 26 featuring America. Proceeds from the Flashback Friday Concert Series will benefit Children's Home Society of NC.

On May 22, Beatles fans will rejoice to the music of **1964: The Tribute**. 1964: The Tribute is widely considered the preminent Beatles tribute band in the world. They have performed over 2900 shows, released albums, and released videos. Rolling Stone magazine has called 1964, "The best Beatles tribute ever." While touring worldwide since the early 80s, they were voted "Best Major Concert Act" and "Best Contemporary Act" by the readers of Campus Activities Today Magazine. They were also voted "Contemporary Music Artists of the Year" by the National Association for Campus Activities, and "Campus Entertainers of the Year" by the Canadian Association for Campus Activities. They have appeared on scores of local television and radio programs throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, and South America.

On June 26, classic rock fans will unite with the music of **America**. The three members of America were barely past their teenage years when they became an overnight musical sensation in the early 1970s. They released records and albums throughout the 70s and 80s with hits including "A Horse with No Name", "Sister Golden Hair" (both of which reached Number 1), "Ventura Highway", and "Tin Man". Touring for well over three decades, America maintains a following and performs over 100 shows per year. On January 16, 2007, America released Here & Now, the band's first major label studio album in over twenty years.

Both concerts will be held at Kathleen Price Bryan Park - Festival Park – located on Davie Street between the YWCA and the Cultural Arts Center. Tickets for 1964: The Tribute are \$15 in advance and \$20 at the gate. Tickets for America are \$25 in advance and \$30 at the gate.
