## INTENSIVE FAMILY PRESERVATION SERVICES



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Every day there are thousands of families across North Carolina who struggle to balance the needs of their children with the challenges of daily life. When these families become overwhelmed, children become at-risk of abuse and neglect and ultimately may end up in the foster care system.

Intensive Family Preservation Services (IFPS) are designed to prevent children from being removed from their homes by strengthening families. The program is implemented based on the Home Builders Model where services are provided for a period of 28 days, 10 hours per week, with a minimum of 40 service hours to address the specific needs of the family.

We are crisis-responsive and utilize evidenced-based and evidence-informed interventions to best meet the needs of families. Our family-centered services empower, prepare, and equip families to safely care, protect, and provide for their children. Our services focus on the family's specific needs, the safety of the child, and special skills development.

Services are delivered to families in their own homes and communities, at times that are most convenient for them. Our IFPS specialists utilize these in-home services to build connections and support systems that enable the family and the child to thrive.
